Program Description:

During each Baltimore Ravens home game throughout the 2009 regular season, a youth group or youth organization will be honored for its **outstanding volunteer service** to communities. Honorees will be selected by a panel of youth service leaders, with the assistance of the Baltimore Ravens, the GOSV and M&T Bank staff, and will receive:

- Up to 100 tickets per group for youth and chaperones to attend a Baltimore Ravens game at M&T Bank Stadium (groups must provide own chaperones and transportation)
- "Honor Rows" T-shirts (to be worn during the game)
- Official in-game recognition of honorees on the SMARTVISION screen
- Recognition on WBFF-Fox 45 and The CW Baltimore public service announcements

Selection Criteria – Honorees will be chosen based on one or more of the following guidelines:

- Volunteer activities and hours accumulated
- The extent to which the youth group or youth organization meets the need of the surrounding community
- The extent to which the youth group or youth organization develops the leadership, personal and social skills of its members
- The involvement of at-risk youth, among the youth group's members and/or the community the youth group serves

**Please Note - Organizations must demonstrate a strong youth volunteer service program to qualify for consideration.*

Honor Rows Limitations – the following are not eligible:

- Individuals and non-501(c)3 groups
- Religious organizations proposing programs that will be directed at sectarian religious purposes
- Schools or school-based programs not linked with a tax exempt 501(c)3 agency

Requirements for application – The following must be submitted for consideration:

- Complete application (see attached pages)
- An essay (no longer than 100 words) on a separate sheet that provides additional information on your groups' community efforts and why they should be honored.
